



## The Club Permit conditions of the FE-FC Holden Car Club of Victoria Inc.

It is important to understand the rules and requirements for Club Permit Registration for our Club – if you have a car with Club Permit Registration or are planning to register one in the near future, please read the following Club conditions:

- You must be a financial member of The FE-FC Holden Car Club of Victoria Inc. for a minimum of 6 months.
- You must show that you are an active Club member by attending Club events in your FE-FC and recording your attendance in the official Club attendance book. This includes monthly General Meetings and official social events. If your FE-FC is not 'on the road', you can attend in another vehicle. Members who reside more than 100km from the CBD may be given a reduced attendance requirement subject to the approval of the Committee.
- Once 6 months have passed and you have attended Club events, you must obtain a Roadworthy Certificate for your vehicle. You are then eligible to apply for a Club Permit.
- Club Permit vehicles transferring from another Club shall also require a Vehicle Safety Inspection
- When your Club Permit is granted, you must attend at least 2 Club events in your Club Permit vehicle per financial year.
- Club Permit registration labels will continue to be issued even though normal registration labels have now ceased being issued. You must have a current Club Permit registration label on your vehicle.
- It is strongly recommended that you retain your VICRoads receipt and store it with your logbook due to issues some members have had regarding proof of current registration.
- New applications for Club Permit Registration will need to comply with the new regulations as of 31 Jan 2015
